



Vinyl Flooring Care & Maintenance Instructions

Thank you for choosing HomeBauer vinyl flooring. To ensure long-lasting performance and maintain its appearance, please follow the care and maintenance guidelines outlined below.

1. General Care Guidelines

- Keep the floor clean by regularly removing dust, dirt, and debris.
 - Use a soft broom, microfiber dust mop, or vacuum with a hard floor attachment.
 - Avoid using abrasive tools or materials that may scratch the surface.
 - Install protective pads under furniture legs to prevent dents and surface wear.
 - Place entrance mats at doorways to reduce tracked-in dirt and moisture.

2. Moisture & Water Exposure

This product is **waterproof under normal household conditions**.

- Spills and water can remain on the surface temporarily without damaging the floor.
 - However, it is recommended to wipe up excess liquid within a reasonable time to maintain surface cleanliness and prevent slipping hazards.
 - Avoid prolonged exposure to standing water at seams or edges, especially near walls and transitions.
 - Ensure proper installation and sealing to prevent water from reaching the subfloor.

3. Cleaning Instructions

- For routine cleaning, use a **damp mop or microfiber mop**.
- Use a **pH-neutral vinyl floor cleaner** when needed.
- Clean up spills using a cloth or mop without delay for best hygiene and appearance.
- Do not use:



- Abrasive cleaners or scouring pads
 - Wax, polish, or oil-based products
 - Harsh chemicals such as bleach or ammonia (unless diluted and approved)

4. Preventative Measures

- Maintain indoor temperature and humidity at normal residential levels.
 - Avoid dragging heavy furniture—lift and place instead.
 - Use protective mats under rolling chairs or heavy furniture.
 - Keep pet nails trimmed to reduce the risk of scratches.

5. Sunlight & Environmental Exposure

- Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight may cause fading or discoloration over time.
 - Use curtains, blinds, or UV protection where necessary.

6. Stain & Damage Prevention

- Wipe up spills such as oil, grease, or colored liquids promptly to avoid staining.
 - Avoid contact with rubber materials (e.g., rubber-backed mats), which may cause discoloration.
 - Use only non-staining mats and rugs labeled as safe for vinyl flooring.

While this flooring is waterproof, improper maintenance, excessive force, or failure to follow these guidelines may result in damage not covered under warranty.
